



FACILITY RENTAL POLICY

Wedding Ceremonies & Photography

- Visits to the gardens for ideas, inspiration or photography consultations are by appointment only to respect the privacy of B&B guests and owners.
- Wedding photography packages must be pre-booked. Photography time is included in all wedding packages.
- Photographic props and equipment are the responsibility of the photographer and the client.
- The Estate gardens will accommodate a maximum of 200 people seated. The Granary garden is suitable for up to 75 seated or 100 standing. Comfortable maximums for the Granary Pavillion is 12. From Sep-May, The Inn will accommodate 20 for an informal ceremony.
- A non-refundable deposit of \$250 is required at the time of booking. Balance is due 30 days prior to the event as well as a refundable damage deposit of \$250. This can be made by means of a signed credit card voucher, cheque or cash.
- Set-up and use of the event area can begin no earlier than 1 day before the event.
- Guests may park on either side of the roadway outside the entrance to the property. Up to four "Wedding Cars" are permitted inside the gates and are welcome to park on the driveway in front of the House or at The Granaries depending on the ceremony location. Special access arrangements can be made for elderly or disabled persons.
- The minister, photographer, caterer, and musician(s)/dj's are welcome to park on the driveway as well.
- Guests access the wedding grounds via short marked woodland or garden trails branching from the main entrance or roadway.
- Chair rental including set-up and take-down as well as the photographer, dj, musician(s), officiator and any other service arrangements are the responsibility of the client.

- Floral arrangements provided by the client are welcome.
- The garden is to be left clean and undisturbed. Decorations ie.helium balloons, confetti, rice, birdseed are not permitted. Bubbles and flower petals are welcome (petals must be picked up after the event).
- Please remember, the Peace Country has had several drought years and fire-hazards are high. Flammable devices (candles,torches, etc) that pose a potential danger to guests or risk of fire are not permitted.
- Smoking is permitted in designated outside areas only. The gravelled area beside the estate lawn and the patio terrace have ashtrays for that purpose. No smoking is allowed at the granary gardens. Cigarette butts do not make pretty additions to the lawns or gardens.
- Outdoor ceremonies and wedding photo shoots are held rain or shine. Back-up provisions such as tents, umbrellas or additional venues are the responsibility of the client. There are NO refunds.
- Soft music is acceptable, (e.g.violin, harp, flute, guitar).Levels for amplified music must be pre-approved.
- Children must be supervised at all times during the ceremony and/or photography sessions.
- Photographers and subjects may not stand or walk in the flower beds.
- While we try to ensure exclusive use of the gardens for each client, multiple wedding groups or events may be scheduled on the same day and may run into each other. Hopefully, not literally.
- You are welcome to bring in snacks and alcoholic or non-alcoholic beverages for the wedding party during photo shoots though drinking and driving is not advisable. The Granaries shall not be held liable for any injuries suffered as a result of intoxication.
- If bottled water is to be provided for wedding guests on hot summer days, prior notification is required to plan for collecting and recycling empties.
- B&B accommodations booked in conjunction with wedding events are eligible for a 10% discount on room rates.
- There is an additional charge for use of the Granaries or the Inn for dressing prior to the wedding ceremony.
- Hosting for wedding receptions is not currently offered.
- A Facility Rental Information for Events form must be filled out and signed at the time of booking.
